



Affordable Housing

Is the Greater St. Louis Region affordable? Absolutely! A new report credits the St. Louis region for being the most affordable among the Top 25 most-populated U.S. metros. The latest C2ER cost-of-living index gives St. Louis a score of 86.4 in affordability, nearly 14 percent better than the national average score of 100. The Gateway City also scored particularly well for housing (74.1), health care (88.9) and transportation (90.3) costs.

To understand how much living in Greater St. Louis costs, it also helps to know the median income. The median household income in the St. Louis County area is \$72,562, higher than the median of \$48,751 for the St. Louis Metro area.

The median home price in St. Louis County is \$280,000. That's right around the U.S. average.

The list includes the hamburger, the hot dog, peanut butter, iced tea, the club sandwich, cotton candy, and the ice cream cone, to name just a few. Here's the "314" on our favorite foods that originated in St. Louis!



MAYFAIR SALAD DRESSING

Magnolia St. Louis (formally The Mayfair Room)

In 1935, Mayfair salad dressing was created by Chef Fred Bangerter and head waiter Harry Amos at The Mayfair Room, Missouri's first five-star restaurant in the Mayfair Hotel.



GOOEY BUTTER CAKE

Park Avenue Coffee (5 locations to choose from)

This must eat St. Louis food was mistakenly invented when the baker accidentally doubled the amount of butter in his cake recipe. The result is a coffee-cake like-base topped with a gooey custard and dusted with powdered sugar.



THE SLINGER

Rooster (2 locations to choose from)

This St. Louis original dish is made by topping a hamburger patty, two fried eggs, and a side of hash browns with a generous ladle of chili, a handful of shredded cheese, and a sprinkle of diced onions.



PROVEL CHEESE AND ST. LOUIS STYLE PIZZA

Imo's (99 locations to choose from)

It's impossible to talk about Provel cheese without mentioning St. Louis style pizza! Provel was supposedly first used by a pizzeria called Luigi's Restaurant in 1953, but got its big break when Ed Imo, the founder of Imo's Pizza, first tasted the not-cheese cheese in the 1960s.



TOASTED RAVOLI

Charlie Gitto's On the Hill (2 locations)

What's better than fresh homemade ravioli? Fresh homemade ravioli that's been breaded and deep-fried! Invented in the city's Italian neighborhood known as The Hill, this famous St. Louis snack is made by dipping ravioli in milk, dredging it in seasoned breadcrumbs, then frying it to a crispy perfection

THE JEWEL BOX

The Jewel Box located on a 17-acre site in Forest Park, was built by the City of St. Louis in 1936 and is operated by the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry. It is listed on the National Historic Register.

ST. LOUIS UNION STATION

St. Louis Union Station was once one of the largest and busiest passenger rail terminals in the world. Today it is home to the St. Louis Aquarium, the 200-foot St. Louis Wheel, a carousel, an 18-hole mini-golf course, and several restaurants



ST. LOUIS CARDINALS

One of the nation's oldest and most successful professional baseball clubs, the Cardinals have won 11 World Series championships, the most of any NL team and second in MLB only to the New York Yankees. The team has won 19 National League pennants, third-most of any team. St. Louis has also won 15 division titles in the East and Central divisions.
